

Each day, MICL offers 2 classes:



A morning class: 10 am to noon. An afternoon class: 1 to 3 pm.

Every day of the week, TEN different classes are offered.



This class schedule will run for 5 weeks. The first, in Fall, is Session A.



Then, a new session, with a <u>new set of</u> classes will run 5 weeks. This is Session B.



Then...you guessed it...is Session C



Three Sessions completes the Fall SEMESTER.

After holiday break, in January we start a Spring Semester of new classes with 3 Sessions.



Mid-May, we start our Summer Semester which offers 6 classes. The Session runs 3 days per week for 12 weeks.



SPECIAL CLASSES

MICL also has a Book Club! Before the start of a Session, Club members choose a book by popular vote.



Book Club members then read the book for the next 5 weeks. At the end of the Session, we get together and discuss it.
